## EXTENDED SERVICES FOR FAMILIES IN NEED.



**Do you know someone who would love to be a foster parent but doesn't have a large amount of time to give?** CFN offers **Respite care** to struggling families. Respite care is short-term help that is utilized while other resources and support are put into place for a family. Monetary compensation is provided for time.

**CFN also provides Rapid Response emergency placements** as an extension of the therapeutic foster care program. This program assists in youths transitioning from various levels of care or provides time to solidify new placements. Youth can stay in this program for just one day or as long as 90 days while long term plans are made. Additional compensation & support is provided for this program.

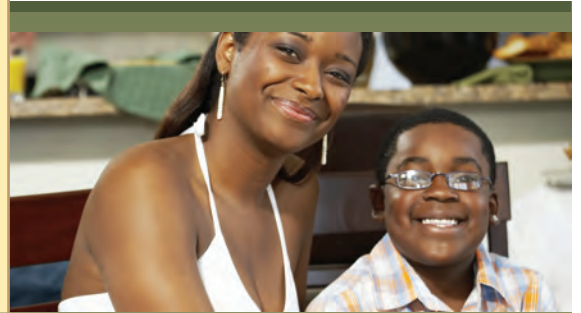


## { THANKS TO OUR LOCAL SUPPORTERS! }

## [ NOTICE REGARDING OUTPATIENT SERVICES IN RALEIGH AND BURLINGTON ]

To our valued patients,

Beginning August 15, 2009 Caring Family Network will no longer provide outpatient services. Effective **August 15, 2009** all outpatient services currently provided by CFN's Burlington and Raleigh offices will become available to consumers through an agency called TASK, Inc.

Consumers should know that they have a choice when it comes to selecting a provider for outpatient services. You have the option to receive services from TASK or from any other provider of your choosing. ### For Burlington Outpatient Consumers:

If you choose TASK as your new outpatient services provider, you will be able to receive services at the same location that you do now. That location is 2732 Anne Elizabeth Drive, Burlington, NC. Please note that in order for TASK to begin providing services to you, we must receive your written authorization to transfer your records. Forms for authorization of transfer of records were sent to each consumer on record on August 1, 2009. Please be on the lookout for your forms to come through the mail. If you have not received them but think you should have already, please contact the Burlington office at **(336) 227-5050**.

If you choose to receive services from an agency other than TASK, you have the right to do so. Burlington consumers are advised to contact the local Alamance / Caswell LME for a referral or contact the Burlington office at (336) 227-5050 and we will be happy to provide you with a list of alternative agencies.

### For Raleigh Outpatient Consumers:

If you choose TASK as your new outpatient services provider, you will need to go to a new location to receive services. This new location is: 3200 Spring Forest Drive, Suite 206, Raleigh, NC. Their phone number is **(919) 758-8797**. Please note that in order for TASK to begin providing services to you, we must receive your written authorization to transfer your records. Forms for authorization of transfer of records were sent to each consumer on record on August 1, 2009. Please be on the lookout for your forms to come through the mail. If you have not received them but think you should have already, please contact the Raleigh office at **(919) 870-8699**.

If you choose to receive services from an agency other than TASK, you have the right to do so. Raleigh consumers are advised to contact the local Wake County Human Services LME for a referral or contact the Raleigh office at (919) 870-8699 and we will be happy to provide you with a list of alternative agencies.
